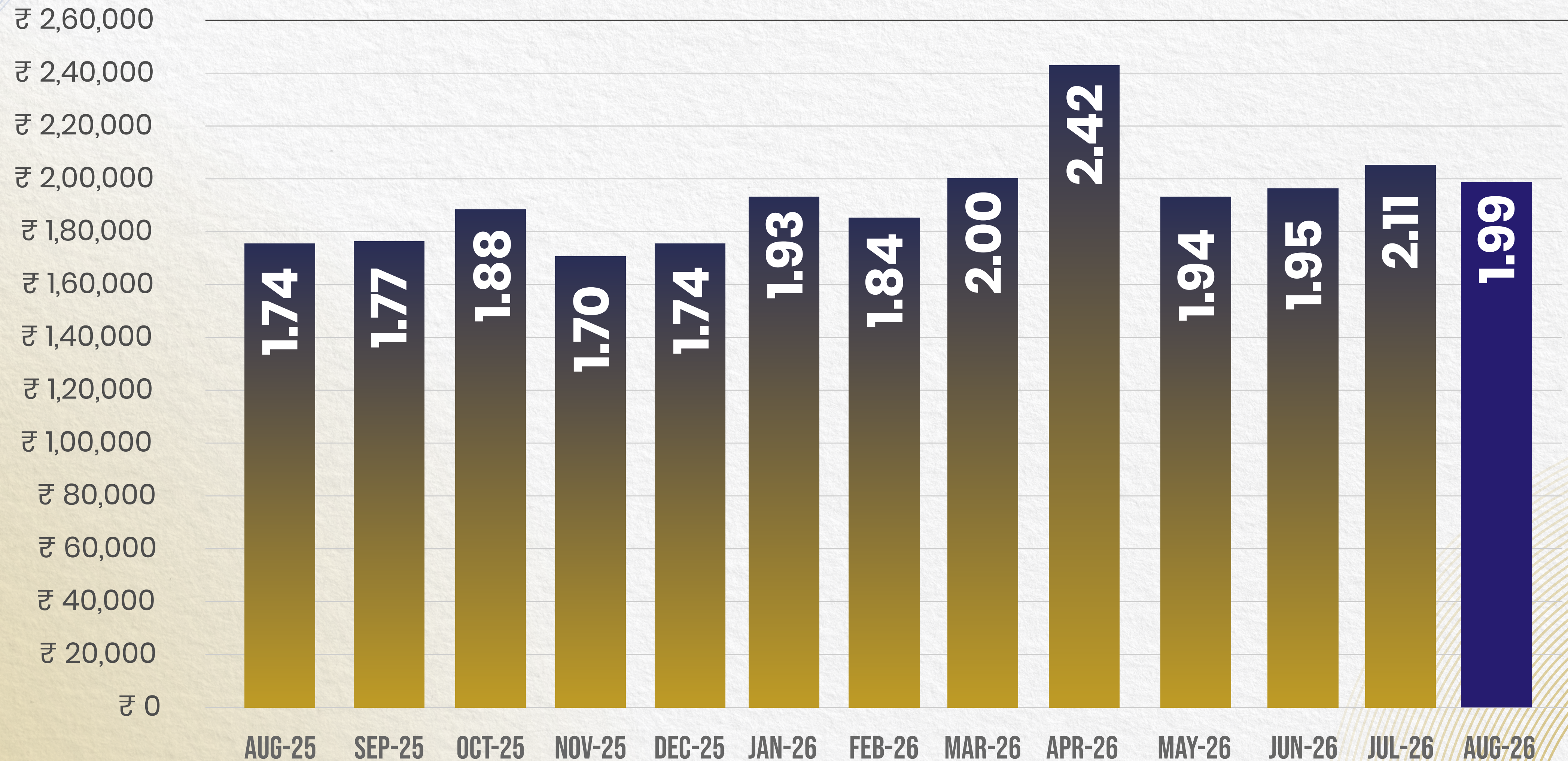

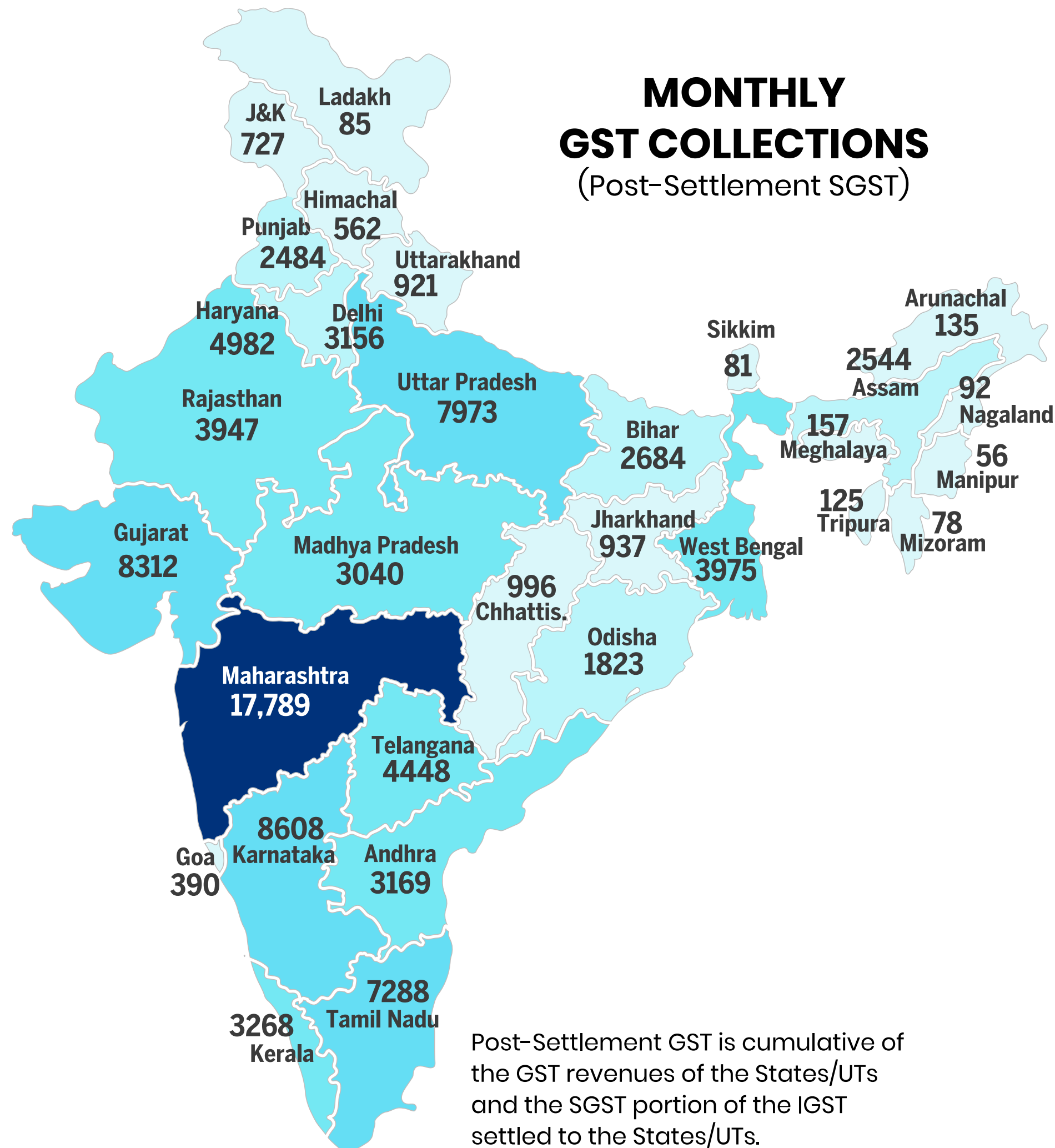
GST Collection trend of last one year

(in Rupees Lakh Crore | Cess not considered)

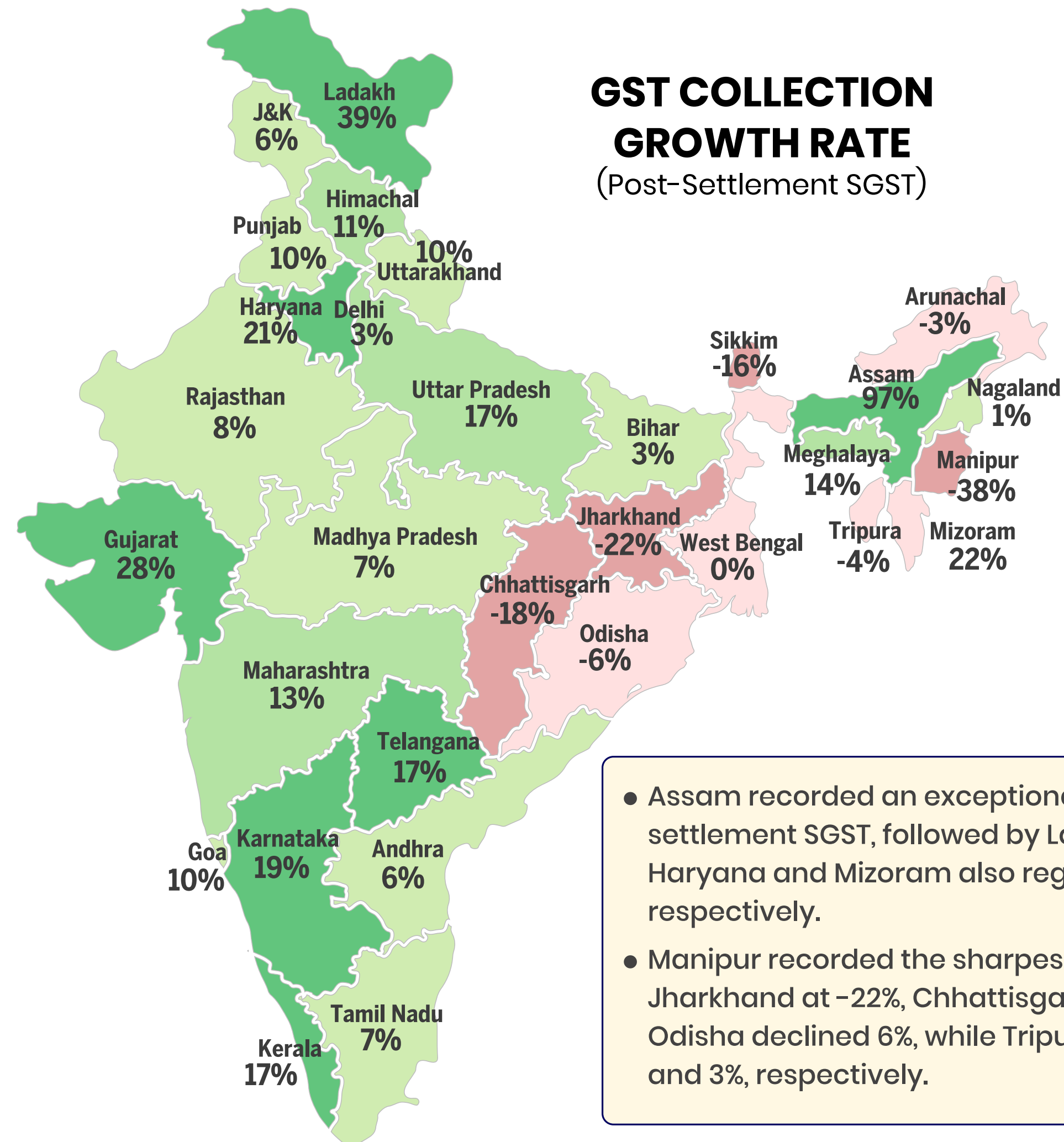

GST COLLECTION GROWTH RATE (Post-Settlement SGST)



- Assam recorded an exceptional 97% increase in post-settlement SGST, followed by Ladakh at 39% and Gujarat at 28%. Haryana and Mizoram also registered growth of 21% and 22%, respectively.
- Manipur recorded the sharpest contraction at -38%, followed by Jharkhand at -22%, Chhattisgarh at -18% and Sikkim at -16%. Odisha declined 6%, while Tripura and Arunachal Pradesh fell 4% and 3%, respectively.



Key Highlights

- Gross GST collections reached ₹1.998 lakh crore in August 2026, registering 14.8% Y-o-Y growth over ₹1.741 lakh crore collected in August 2025.
- Domestic GST revenue grew 9.3% Y-o-Y to ₹1.372 lakh crore, while GST revenue from imports surged 29.0% to ₹62,604 crore, making imports a major contributor to the month's headline growth.
- Total refunds increased sharply by 67.9% Y-o-Y to ₹31,795 crore. Consequently, net GST revenue stood at ₹1.681 lakh crore, recording a comparatively moderate 8.3% Y-o-Y growth.
- FY 2026-27 collections up to August remained robust: cumulative gross GST revenue reached ₹10.43 lakh crore, up 11.0%, while cumulative net GST revenue stood at ₹8.90 lakh crore, up 9.0%.
- State revenues strengthened after IGST settlement. Aggregate post-settlement SGST reached ₹95,531 crore in August, up 13% Y-o-Y, compared with an 8% increase in pre-settlement SGST. Assam (+97%), and Gujarat (+28%) were among the strongest performers on the post-settlement measure.





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
